



EXPLANATION

Re. the procedure for the delivery of submersible sensors for pCO₂ recording – II for the Institute of Oceanology of the Polish Academy of Sciences (procedure no. IO/ZN/6/2025)

The Contracting Authority – the Institute of Oceanology of the Polish Academy of Sciences – provides an explanation in response to the following question submitted on March 5th, 2025 in the procedure for **the delivery of submersible sensors for pCO₂ recording – II** for the Institute of Oceanology of the Polish Academy of Sciences (procedure no. IO/ZN/6/2025)

Question

„(...) what dates would I put into the highlighted part? Is it the date of signature until a certain time?”

§ 2

- The subject of the contract is **the delivery of four submersible sensors for pCO₂ recording** for the Institute of Oceanology of the Polish Academy of Sciences in accordance with the submitted bid of (date) and the Contract Notice in the area of science dated to with appendices (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Contract Notice’), being an integral part hereof.
- Under the contract the Contractor is obligated to transfer ownership of the subject of the contract and hand over the subject of the contract and the Contracting Authority is obligated to collect the subject of the contract and to pay the Contractor the price (the remuneration set in § 4 section 1 of the contract).
- Description of requirements and technical specification:
 - 1) measurement ranges: 0 – 2000 µatm;
 - 2) detector: Non-Dispersive Infrared (NDIR);
 - 3) internal data recording;
 - 4) resolution: 0.1% of maximum range;
 - 5) power consumption: max 0.45 W (max 35 mA @ 12 V);
 - 6) equilibration: max 3 minutes;
 - 7) warm up time: max 3 minutes;
 - 8) sample rate: at least every 2 seconds;
 - 9) detector accuracy ±3% (of maximum range);
 - 10) submersible to 600 m;

Response

The Contracting Authority indicates that Appendix no. 3 to the Contract Notice is only a contract template which does not have to be submitted with the Contractor’s offer. Therefore, the Contractor does not fill in the blanks in the above file. Appendix no. 3 will be filled in by the Contracting Authority before signing the contract with the Contractor whose offer will be selected as the most advantageous one. The fragment of the template highlighted in the quoted question will be completed by filling in the date of the selected bid and the date of the publication of the Contract Notice its Public Information Bulletin page (in the proceedings in question, that will be March 5th, 2025).
